What is Tapestry?

Tapestry is a secure online Learning Journal used to record photos, observations and comments, in line with the Early Years Foundation Stage curriculum, to build up a record of your child's experiences during their time with us. This system allows us to work with parents and carers to share information and record the children's play and learning inside, and outside the classroom.



How Does School use Tapestry?

- Send reminders/requests via memos.
- Observations of learning- whole class, small group, 1:1.
- Observations of play within the Continuous Provision.
- ‘Concerns/no Concerns’ to track development.
- Flag observations to Development Matters.

How Can Parents use Tapestry?

- Days out.
- Fun activities.
- Share the work you are doing with the Phonics newsletter.
- Reading, Maths, Writing.
- Comment on observations sent home by school.
- Read and respond to memos.

Tapestry is not and should not be used as a messaging tool to communicate with school. Absences, appointments and any other related queries, problems, or questions should be reported to the school office.
